The City of Sioux Falls has contracted with D & G Concrete Construction, Inc. of Sioux Falls, for the 69th Street and Western Avenue Expansion and Reconstruction project. The project has begun with the installation of new traffic signals at the intersection of Western Avenue and Ralph Rogers Road. The traffic signals are anticipated to be complete and operational the week of April 17th.

The project will be constructed in phases. The first phase of work, beginning April 17th, will include pavement removals, grading, installation of storm sewer and water main, and paving the north half of 69th Street from Landau Circle east to Western Avenue and the west half of Western Avenue from 69th Street north to Remington Place. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained along 69th Street and Western Avenue during the first phase of construction. Access from S. Grand Prairie Drive on the north side of 69th Street will be closed during Phase 1A construction.
