This project includes the complete reconstruction of 69th Street from Landau Circle to Minnesota Avenue, and Western Avenue from LaQuinta Street to Remington Place. 69th Street will be widened to include four lanes with a center-colored median, and Western Avenue will be widened to a five-lane section. Other improvements include minor storm sewer and water main work, new traffic signals, a 10-foot wide side path along Western Avenue, and ADA improvements throughout the project.

One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained along 69th Street during construction. Western Avenue will also have one lane of traffic in each direction during construction with the exception of a 2-3 week period where Western Avenue will be closed south of 69th Street. Access to the side streets will be maintained as much as possible, but some closures of the side streets should be expected during construction.

Bids for this project will be opened on March 23, with construction expected to begin in late April or early May. The major construction work will be completed by late October this year, with some sidewalk and median work extending into the spring of 2018.
